### How We Work Together

To access Children's Treatment Network, simply call 1-866-377-0286. Parents can contact the Network directly, or be referred by a physician or agency.

Services are provided through Local Teams that are made up of professionals from different member agencies and organizations serving kids with special needs in Simcoe and York.

The Network also works closely with organizations such as Sick Kids Hospital and Bloorview Kids Rehab to coordinate specialized services and care, where they are needed.

When you call, a coordinator will ask a series of questions to find out your child's needs. The child and family team assigned to you will develop a care plan and coordinate the services you require. This plan will change as your child develops and reaches various transition stages, such as starting school.

## Who We Are

Children's Treatment Network is a new way of providing care for kids in Simcoe and York with special physical, developmental, and communication needs. We remove many barriers that parents face by providing one point of contact for a single plan of coordinated care for children and youth with multiple disabilities.

Children's Treatment Network coordinates all the services needed to help kids with special needs take part in daily living, school and play. We bring together regional healthcare, recreation, education, social and community services to develop a long-term plan of care that is adapted throughout all the stages of your child's development.

## Our Kids

Children's Treatment Network will serve more than 4,200 children from birth to age 19 with multiple disabilities in Simcoe and York.

Services are available to children and youth who may already be receiving support from Network partners and require additional ongoing, intensive or specialized rehabilitation treatment. This includes children with a wide range of disabilities and complex conditions such as:

- Cerebral palsy
- Muscular dystrophy
- Acquired brain injury
- Developmental and learning difficulties
- Spina bifida
- Autism or pervasive developmental disorder (PDD)
- Chronic and/or long-term medical conditions that require intensive therapy, specialized equipment or travel to treatment centres outside of the community
