



Rehabilitation, Clinical and Specialty Services Single Plan of Care Services Local Sites and Supports

Children's Treatment Network Partners provide a wide range of healthcare, recreation, education and community services for children with special needs – at home, in school and throughout the community.

Many of these children may have complex physical, developmental and/or communication needs. In order to provide more effective support for these children, additional funding from Children's Treatment Network was invested to expand the range of services provided by Network Partners so families have access to a continuum of rehabilitation and clinical services as well as specialty services – closer to home.



Children with long-term multiple special needs residing in Simcoe or York, from birth to age 19 (or up to age 21 if attending school) who require treatment and/or support from multiple service providers may be eligible for:

2 The Network's Coordinated Single Plan of Care Approach which includes:

- ACCESS and Service Navigation to all services and supports available across the Network
- A Shared Electronic Record
- Support for development of Child & Family teams

Teamwork is at the heart of the Network's single plan of care approach. Network Partner professionals serving kids with multiple special needs work together with families in Child and Family teams to set goals based on the family's visions and develop an integrated Single Plan of Care. New tools, including a shared electronic record and common assessments, reduce the need for you to tell your child's story over and over again. Professionals on your Child and Family team share clinical information, coordinate services and work together to monitor your child's progress, through all the stages of their development.

The Network also works closely with organizations such as SickKids and Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital to coordinate specialized services and care, where they are needed.

3 Local Sites and Supports for Families & Professionals

Local Sites including 2 Resource Centres co-located with a range of Network Partners, provide families and professionals with additional access to integrated services, clinical facilities, specialized equipment and supports and educational events in their community.

Supporting families with information and knowledge is a Network commitment. Parents and providers often work together to hold information sessions, workshops and special events at Local Sites that focus on topics of most interest to families, like Information Fairs about services, recreation programs, and specialized equipment; Educational seminars on financial planning, funding and subsidy opportunities; Parent support groups. The Network's Family Resource Site is an online discussion forum for parents, caregivers and families. Families can post messages and share tips, insights and ideas with other parents. - In addition to guiding referrals across the Network, Service Navigators at ACCESS lay the groundwork for coordinated care planning. They discuss your child and family's needs, open a shared electronic record and obtain consent for team members to share information. Network ACCESS also works with families to determine if there are any additional concerns that require attention and will assist you to connect with all required services.
