## Trojans Dive In to help today at car wash

September 24, 2011 (STAFF) -- Barrie Trojan Swim Club members are holding a car-wash fundraiser today to bring hospital beds home for five local children with multiple special needs.

Proceeds go directly to the Children's Treatment Network Family Fund. The goal is to raise \$1,500 to cover costs for five in-home hospital beds. Having a hospital bed at home makes it easier for children with limited mobility to adjust their sleeping position for optimum breathing and rest and helps their families get them in and out of bed more easily.

The Holiday Inn Express & Suites Barrie has partnered with the swim team to help them meet their \$1,500 goal.

In addition to hosting the car wash, drivers of the first 20 cars will receive 5,000 Priority Club reward points that can be used at any InterContinental Hotel.

"We're looking forward to trading in our swim goggles for buckets and sponges," says swim club head coach Jason Morawski. "This is all about teaming together to help families in our own community.

"Bring your car in for a wash so we can give these Barrie kids the beds they need."

The car wash will be held between 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., at 506 Bryne Dr., near Highway 400 and Mapleview Drive. The minimum donation is \$10 per vehicle.

The Barrie Trojans have been offering a competitive swim program since 1984, producing several international, national and provincial level swimmers.

They currently have more than 170 competitive swimmers competing for Barrie, and more than 150 more young athletes swimming in our entry-level program.
